

ON THE STATUS OF *ENALLAGMA YPSILON* NEEDHAM, 1942 (ZYGOPTERA: COENAGRIONIDAE) AND *MICRATHYRIA CARLOTA* NEEDHAM, 1942 (ANISOPTERA: LIBELLULIDAE)

Going through the correspondence of the late Dr J. Rácenis, I found an interesting note in a letter sent to him by Dr M.J. Westfall, Gainesville, dated Oct. 23, 1962, which reads as

follows: "Have you any reason to believe that Needham's *Enallagma ypsilon* is not Calvert's *novaehispaniae*? From the type which I have here I can not see any differences. Of course this is close to *cardenium*, *coecum* and a new species Mrs. Gloyd is working with. Also I believe that Needham's *carlota* is just *ocellata dentiens* in the genus *Micrathyria*.
