

THE ODONATA OF THE ARGENTINE REPUBLIC II.

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RESUMEN

Odonata de la República Argentina II. — En la segunda parte de su trabajo sobre las especies argentinas del orden *Odonata*, el autor da notas sobre las especies del sub-orden *Zygoptera*, describiendo el nuevo género *Argentagrion* (basado sobre la especie *Acanthagrion ambiguum* Ris) y las especies nuevas *Telebasis willinki* y *Argia missionensis*. Hay una bibliografía con 54 referencias.

Referring to the first part of this paper, since my description of *Aeshna viridivittata* sp. nov. was written, I have received a report on a duplicate male specimen which I had submitted to Dr. Philip, P. Calvert of Philadelphia, who at present is engaged on a monograph on the South American Aeshnas. He is inclined to think that the species is related to, if not identical, with Forster's *Limnetron antarcticum*. He has examined two other males and two females, one of the former from the State of Rio Janeiro and the other from «Brazil». He has also made detailed notes on Forster's type male of *L. antarcticum* and of another female labelled as such by Forster himself. From all these specimens, *A. viridivittata* differs in the important character of possessing a more open venation. As Dr. Calvert will be including the full results of his examinations in his forthcoming monograph, it will suffice here to merely give his final summing-up, viz, — «I am inclined to look upon it as a subspecies or geographical race of *Limnetron antarcticum* Forster, characterized by its less dense venation». Dr. Calvert also remarks that *Epiaeschna debilis* Karsch must be considered,
