

**STUDIES ON NEOTROPICAL
PROTONEURIDAE. 20. NEONEURA KIAUTAI
SPEC. NOV. FROM SOUTHEASTERN BRAZIL
(ZYGOPTERA, PROTONEURIDAE)**

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ABSTRACT

Neoneura kiautai, sp.n. is described and illustrated. It is close to *N. ethela* but differs mainly by the shape of the decumbent process of cercus and the colour of abdominal segments 7-10.

INTRODUCTION

In his review of the genus *Neoneura* Garrison (1999) mentions 23 species, most of them Neotropical, with only two species reaching the Nearctic region. Since then, four new species have been described (Machado, 2002, 2003, 2005), all from Brazil. We describe now an additional Brazilian species from the State of Minas Gerais, thus increasing the number of known species to 28. Out of these, 18 occur
